23.64	Declarations of interest in agenda items and requests for dispensation
	There were none.
23.65	Apologies and consideration of reasons for absence
	Apologies were received and accepted from Cllrs Andrew Hallett, Pam Macklewain-Hallett,
	and Emma Wells
23.66	Minutes of the Town Council meeting held on 11 th August 2023, and of the Annual Town
	Council Meeting held on 15 th May 2023
	The Council RESOLVED to approve both sets of minutes as a true record of the meetings,
	and they were signed as such by the Chair.
23.67	Updates from minutes (not covered elsewhere on the agenda)
23.671	CCTV
	The Council noted the confirmation from North Yorkshire Council that the members
	discretionary grant can be used for the revised project, per item 22.59, as it is still CCTV
	and still covering Bedale Park. The Clerk met officers on site to discuss the lines of sight in
	the park for the CCTV installation, and along with Cllr Coates visited the CCTV monitoring facility in Northallerton to look at the potential lines of sight of the new camera. The CCTV
	installation is expected before the next Town Council meeting.
23.672	Remembrance Day
	The Council noted that no further information was available regarding local volunteers
	receiving traffic management training for this event.
	Action: Cllr Coates to liaise with Bedale Scouts and Guides
23.68	Reports of recent activity
23.681	Reports of activity from external body meetings attended by Councillors
	Cllrs Coates, Howe, Mollard and Noone had attended various activities over the church
	clock 150 th anniversary celebration weekend. The Council noted that the event had been
22 692	successful and commended the organisers.
23.682	Report from North Yorkshire Council representative NYC Cllr David Webster reported that he had recently attended a seminar regarding
	refugees, emergency plans, the homeless, and housing options. Regarding the emergency
	plan, Cllr Coates confirmed that Bedale Town Council has one in place. It was noted that
	the plan should be updated to include a NYC contact.
	Action: Cllr Webster to notify Clerk of the appropriate contact

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23.69	Financial matters:
	Financial statement and approvals for payment The Council noted the financial statement as circulated and RESOLVED to approve the
	following payments: staff salaries; Morgan's (£1,995 grass cutting and grounds
	maintenance, and £880 repainting Bedale Park bollards and chains); PKF Littlejohn
	(£420+VAT, external audit fee); Bedale Window Cleaning (£225, bus shelter and bandstand
	cleaning); Darren Garside (£160.00, tree surgery); SLCC (£146, Asst Clerk membership);
	Rotherham Borough Council (£110.00 Yorkshire Day event); Mayoral expenses (£77.85 travel to undertake duties); TWC Facilities Ltd (£13.08, paper towels); HM Land Registry
	(£6, searches); and Bedale CIO (£10.00 room hire). The Council also formally approved the
	expenditure necessarily agreed between meetings of £755+VAT to Rentokil Initial Ltd for
	rodent-proof stainless steel mesh around the Bedale Park bin store.
	The Council NOTED the following recurring payments: North Yorkshire Council £56
	(business rates for Market); British Gas £98.80 (electricity for Market Place); Opus Energy £27.20 (electricity for Bridge St toilets); LCC Communications £46.90 (telephone /
	broadband); Yorwaste £91.86 (car boot sale waste collection).
	Receipts were noted of: £696 (Market stall rents); £20 (Bedale Park hire fees); £50 (Xmas
	market stall rents).
	The cash book balance after these transactions was noted as being £54,404.18
23.70	Planning matters
	The Council considered the following planning applications:
	Regarding ZB23/01665/FUL for a new dwelling in the grounds behind 4 Sussex Street, the Council RESOLVED to approve the decision necessarily agreed between meetings that the
	Council object to this application on the grounds that the proposed new residential unit
	would have a detrimental impact on adjacent properties by being situated too close to its
	adjoining property, that the new property itself would be lacking in facilities, that the
	single parking space provided would be inadequate for the new property alongside the existing 4 Sussex Street, and that the impact of the adjacent listed building had not been
	considered in the application.
	The Council NOTED the approval by NYC of ZB23/01459/FUL for a single storey rear
	extension at 30 South End.
23.71	Twinning
	The Council RESOLVED to take on the work of the Bedale Twinning Association as a Town Council activity and agreed that there should be a working group consisting of members of
	the public and Councillors. The balance of Twinning Association monies would be
	transferred to the Council and ringfenced for twinning activity, and it was noted that there
	will no financial implication to the Council, other than a small amount of staff time.
	Action: Size and composition of the working group to be on October's agenda
23.72	Whole Council training
	The Council RESOLVED to book a session for the full Council, plus Clerk and Assistant Clerk, provided by the Yorkshire Local Councils Association and covering the role, responsibilities,
	rights and possibilities of a Town Council, at a cost of £384
	Action: Clerk to progress

23.73	Staffing Committee
	The Council RESOLVED to replace the Employment Working Group with a Staffing
	Committee, following a recommendation from Yorkshire Local Councils Association, and
	noting National Association of Local Councils guidelines that, employment should be managed by a formal committee of the Council.
	The Council then APPROVED the Committee's terms of reference, based upon those
	circulated, but with the committee to be composed of five Councillors and chaired by the
	Chair of the Council, and with the note added that the Chair of the Council will usually line manage the Clerk.
	Finally, the Council RESOLVED to appoint Cllrs Hallett, Howe, Macklewain-Hallett, and
	Mollard to join Cllr Coates on the Committee.
23.74	Standing Orders and Financial Regulations
	The Council noted that the de minimis threshold for public contracts has been raised from
	£25,000 to £30,000, and RESOLVED to approve the revised Bedale Town Council Standing
	Orders and Financial Regulations as circulated to reflect this change, and to replace four
	references to "Hambleton District Council" with "North Yorkshire Council" following the
	creation of the new unitary authority.
